2. Safety Near Schools

City leaders are considering lowering school zone speed limits to 15–20 mph, adding flashing signs, and redesigning dangerous roads near schools. How should the City approach school zone speed limits and enforcement?

It should be automatic. People pay attention when driving slower.

The island medians in the center of Ingersoll are confusing; island medians should only be used to denote pedestrian crossings and bus stops; they loose their effect otherwise.
